Meteors Dates - Saturdays

- January 12, 21 (MLK Monday), 26, 2013
- February 2, 9, 23, 2013
- March 2, 9, 16, 23, 2013

If the resort makes a decision to cancel any seasonal program due to inclement weather or road conditions, make up days will be provided.

Attendance on the first day is very important, please make every effort to attend. Coaches will observe student's abilities and the groups will be formed accordingly. Students not attending the first day will have their ability estimated and placed in an existing group.

ATTENDANCE

It is in your child's best interest to make every scheduled Meteors session so that they progress at the same rate as the group. In the event that a child misses a session and as a result, can no longer perform at the groups new skill level, they may need to be placed in a different class.

ARRIVAL

Please plan to arrive at the California Main Lodge at 8:45am dressed, with equipment, and ready to go. Meteors starts at 9:00 am sharp and we do not want to leave anyone behind!

PARKING

You may park in the 15 minute parking area directly in front of the California Main Lodge. This is to allow for the safe and convenient delivery and pick up of your child participating in the Meteors program. If you choose to stay and ski while your child is in Meteors, you will need to move your vehicle to the regular parking area. Vehicles left within the 15 minute parking area will be removed at the owner's expense. Thank you for your help and cooperation in maintaining this privilege for Meteor parents.

DROP OFF

Please bring your child to the top of the stairs, located on the right side of the lodge, behind the California Children's Center. On the first day, both coaches and supervisors will be on hand to answer any questions. We will gather the kids together and form them into groups based on their ability level. After the first day, please check in with your child's coach when you drop him or her off. Also, please be sure your child has money for lunch or a packed lunch.

All Meteors classes depart promptly at 9:00 am, please arrive on time.

PICK UP

Meteors ends at 3:00 pm, behind the California Children's Center. Remember that five minutes is a very long time when a child is waiting for a parent. We appreciate your cooperation in being prompt at the day's end. If you are unable to pick up your child on time, Call us as soon as possible at 530-542-5131.

LUNCH

Coaches have the flexibility to eat lunch at any of the mountain lodges. Children should either carry their lunch in their jacket pockets and buy a drink or purchase lunch here. **It is not recommended that children carry school sized backpacks or fanny packs due to the forward position that this creates when your child is riding a chairlift.**

HELMETS

The coaches are trained and instructed on the importance of class handling and group safety. However, you can never be too careful when working with children, therefore **we require helmets for all children participating in Meteors.** We have helmets available for purchase at the California Lodge retail store.

WHAT TO WEAR

It's all about fun! Never allow your child to come to Meteors unprepared for the elements. It's no fun to ski or ride when you are cold. If you are unsure of the weather, dress your child in multiple layers. We can always take a layer off if needed.

Requirements:

- Waterproof Jacket
- Waterproof Gloves or Mittens
- Waterproof Pants
- 1 Pair of Ski/Snowboard Socks (not cotton)
- Goggles or Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Child's Season Pass - Please plan to pick up your child's season pass before the first day of Meteors.
- Helmet
- Ski/Snowboard Equipment

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Should the resort be impacted by extremely high winds, blizzard conditions, driving rain or any other condition which forces the resort to operate less than half of the scheduled lifts, we will consider cancelling Meteors for the day. The Ski and Ride School management will discuss the potential status of the resort and the severity of the conditions with the Mountain Operations department. We will make a decision as to whether Meteors will be held for the day by 8:15 am. We will immediately begin calling parents to notify you if Meteors is cancelled. In the event of a cancellation, we will utilize one of the scheduled make up days.

Please be sure we have your correct phone number so we can reach you in the event of a cancellation.

EMERGENCIES

If you need to get in touch with your child, please contact the Ski & Ride School Administration office at (775) 586-7000 Ext. 6206. If your child becomes ill or injured while on the mountain, our Ski Patrol will immediately take them to one of our first aid centers for evaluation. You will be contacted at the emergency telephone numbers you have provided.

COACHES

The role of a Meteors Coach is very important. Meteors Coaches are hand selected from our Ski & Ride School staff. Coaches are chosen based on their skiing/riding backgrounds, their passion and experience working with children. We encourage you to be active in your child's skiing/riding development and ask questions about his or her progress.

END OF SEASON EVALUATIONS

You can expect to see an end of season evaluation from your child's coach on his or her performance. We will cover areas such as skill development, skiing/riding etiquette, attitude and progress.
